### **B. General Information**

The following items are included with RECYCLEPAK® Dental Waste Kits:

#### **½ Gallon Poly Pail (Supply-062 & Supply-125)**

The ½ gallon poly pail is designed to be used for the shipment of “wet” amalgam wastes and must be placed inside the 2 gallon poly pail. The ½ gallon poly pail can hold dental amalgam, waste contact amalgam, amalgam sludge, vacuum pump filters, side chair traps and/or extracted teeth. Disinfection and packaging instructions must be followed. Any rinse water used, should be placed into the ½ gallon poly pail as well.

#### **2 Gallon Poly Pail (Supply-062 only)**

The 2 gallon poly pail is designed to hold the ½ gallon poly pail. Additional “dry” dental wastes such as lead x-ray foil, non-contact amalgam and empty plastic vials can be placed into the space around the ½ gallon pail. These wastes MUST be placed into sealed plastic bags or jars prior to being placed into the 2 gallon poly pail. The total net weight of mercury in the final package must not exceed one pound (approximately two pounds of amalgam).

*Per regulations set forth in 40 CFR 273.18(d), 40 CFR 273.38(d), and 40 CFL 264.12(b), Veolia agrees to receive shipment of dental waste, as described above, from the Generator.*

#### **5 Gallon Poly Pail (Supply-125 only)**

The 5 gallon poly pail is designed to hold the ½ gallon poly pail and/or inline filter cartridges. Additional “dry” dental waste such as lead x-ray foil, non-contact amalgam and empty plastic vials can be placed into the space around the ½ gallon poly pail or filter cartridge. These wastes MUST be placed into sealed separate bags or jars prior to being placed into the 5 gallon poly pail. The total net weight of mercury in the final package must not exceed one pound (approximately two pounds of amalgam).

*Per regulations set forth in 40 CFR 273.18(d), 40 CFR 273.38(d), and 40 CFL 264.12(b), Veolia agrees to receive shipment of dental waste, as described above, from the Generator.*

### **C. Generator Certifications**

I certify that all information submitted in this form contains true and accurate descriptions of this waste. The dental waste enclosed in the RECYCLEPAK® is not an infectious/regulated medical waste or has been rendered non-infectious. The dental waste in the RECYCLEPAK® is not radioactive. The Generator is a conditionally exempt (very) small quantity generator as defined by US EPA regulations 40 CFR 261.5, or the dental waste within the RECYCLEPAK® container is otherwise exempted from regulation as a hazardous waste. All relevant information regarding known or suspected hazards in the possession of the generator has been disclosed.
